

State Mandated Health Report

Eugene Waldorf School abides by all state immunization laws. For students in all Oregon schools, families may choose which immunizations their children receive and when.

These 2018 immunization rates are being posted in compliance with state requirements adopted July 27, 2015. Exemption rates include not only families that choose to opt out of vaccinations, but also families that had their children immunized later than the state-mandated schedules. Many EWS families choose to immunize on a later schedule than the state mandate.

Immunization rate* for DTaP/Tadp is 50% and the exemption rate is 50%. Varicella, 47% immunized and 53% delayed or exempted. Measles, 47% immunized and 53% delayed or exempted. Polio, 40% immunized and 54% delayed or exempted. MMR, 49% immunized, and the delayed and exempted rate is not requested by the state. Hep B, 43% immunized, and 57% delayed or exempted. Hep A immunized rate is not requested by the state, and the delayed or exempted rate is 56%. Mumps immunized rate is not requested by the state, and the delayed or exempted rate is 51%. Rubella immunized rate is not requested by the state, and the delayed or exempted rate is 51%.
